Guidance

Legal basis

According to Art. 31.2 of Parliamentary Act no 33, dated 19th May 2008, on Duties, Levies and Fees Payable on Registration of Motor Vehicles in the Faroe Islands, Akstovan can allow individuals temporarily resident in the Faroe Islands to import a motor vehicle for personal use only for up to one year without having to re-register that vehicle or pay duties or levies in accordance with Parliamentary Act no. 33. Such vehicles may not be used for commercial purposes.

Motor vehicles that have been granted exemption pursuant to this legislation may be kept in the Faroe Islands up to a maximum of 12 months in a 24-month period, without having to re-register or pay duties and levies.

Pursuant to Art. 68.2 of Executive Order no 34, dated 14th April 1983, on Registration of Motor Vehicles, any vehicle must be registered, or have its license plate removed and delivered to Akstovan, no later than 14 days after its owner (user) establishes a permanent address in the Faroe Islands, after a vehicle is imported, or is transferred to an owner (user) resident in the Faroe Islands.

The following documents must be enclosed with the application:

- 1) Copy of the vehicle registration certificate.
- 2) Proof of valid liability insurance (green card) taken out outside the Faroe Islands.
- 3) Documentation from a Faroese employer, educational facility or similar regarding the duration of education or employment.
- 4) Documentation from the Danish Motor Vehicle Agency (Motorstyrelsen) "Permit for continued registration in Denmark when leaving the country for more than 185 days" (only applicable to Danish registered vehicles).
- 5) Copy of driving license.
